BOARDING

\$325-\$375/mo basic boarding fee/ 2 or more Leases \$300 mo. W 90 day contract.

Boarding Options:

A – 16 stalls with “turn out paddocks” attached to the indoor event arena 240’ X110’

The following services will be included in the boarding fee:

Stalls

15 Full-size (12’ x 12’ stalls with large paddocks. Stallions will be an additional charge. Please ask for details. Private stalls with large corrals available.

Spaces for All

The meadow will be divided for many uses including separation of mares & geldings. No pasture boarding available.

Turn Out – Dry Lot Corrals

Various corrals for turn out and grazing; Dry Lot corrals; Cross Fenced pasture; Three round pens

Secure Tack Rooms & Client Lounge:

Heated dry private tack rooms. Client required to bring their own lock.

Daily stall mucking

Weekly full clean-out with pine bedding

Feeding 2-3 times daily

Per individual horses requirement.

Fresh well water; heaters provided for all water troughs

Horse washing area/ Indoor and Outdoor

Heated Restrooms & Private Showers (for humans!)

Extra charge for blankets or other special needs. Cost depends on the horse & exact requirement.
